Spinal Cord Stimulator Trial instructions:

If you have any questions or concerns about the procedure, or if you need to change your appointment date or time, please call 801-294-7246.

Before the procedure

- You may not eat or drink for 8 hours prior to procedure, except for sips of water with your medications.
- Discontinue use of any NSAIDS five days prior to procedure.
- Discontinue use of blood thinners including Aspirin as directed by physician.
- Arrange for someone to drive you home.
- Procedure may take one to two hours depending on surgical factors.

Tell your physician:

- -If you are taking an antibiotic for an infection.
- -If you are allergic to iodine, latex or local anesthetics.
- -If you had a temperature of 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or 38 degrees Celsius or higher in the last two weeks.

After the procedure

• Procedure site may be sore for one to two days. You may get a bruise at procedure site.

Care following the procedure

- Rest the day of your procedure and avoid strenuous activity.
- Resume your usual diet.
- No bathing, soaking, or showering while stimulator leads are in place, procedure site must remain completely dry
- Inform our office of any signs of infection at procedure site. Example: redness, swelling, fluid discharge, etc.
